Fast Facts • Borrowing

You may need to borrow when you are subtracting numbers with two or more digits. If a digit in the number you are subtracting is bigger than a digit in the same column you are subtracting from, you need to borrow from the next column.

Example:



In the ones column 6 is bigger than 2. You will need to borrow 1 ten from the tens column and put it in the ones column. 12-6=6Finish by subtracting the tens column. Since 1 ten has been taken from the tens column the 8 is now a 7. 7-4=3
