















Working Towards Skilled Trades in Manufacturing

is an 18-week project that will provide 16 individuals who are interested in exploring careers in the Industrial/ Manufacturing sector with:

- 10 weeks job readiness training and academic upgrading
- 12 hours safety training
- a training allowance equivalent to minimum wage
- an 8-week paid work placement with an employer within the Industrial/ Manufacturing sector that is within a 1-hour commute of their home and has full-time jobs available
- support registering as an Apprentice (where relevant)
- career exploration and career development support and guidance.

Childcare and travel allowances available as needed.

Potential careers include: welder, sheet metal worker, machinist, general production worker/machine operator, industrial electrician, millwright, pipe fitter, etc.

Criteria:

- 18 years of age or older and not in school;
- unemployed or underemployed;
- lives within a 1.5 hour commute to Dartmouth, Nova Scotia.

Preference will be given to women, youth, members of diverse communities and visible minorities.
