Start with the Story

Read the story together.

Ask your child what they think is happening based on the picture.

Emphasize the sound of /b/ whenever possible.

Be sure to practise the /b/ sound action - pretend to hit a ball with a bat, saying /b/ /b/ /b/ /b/.


