Ask your child what they think is happening based on the picture.

Emphasize the sound of /j/ whenever possible.

Be sure to practise the /j/ sound action - pretend to wobble like jelly on a plate, saying /j/ /j/ /j/ /j/.


Encourage your child to make a jellyfish handprint. Once dry, add eyes and a mouth.




