

Start with the Story


Read the story together.

Emphasize the sound of /o/ whenever possible.

Be sure to practise the /o/sound action - pretend to turn a light switch on and off, and say /o/ /o/ /o/ /o/.





Song: The Water Gurgles Down the Drain


Ideas to make it fun:
