

Start with the Story

Read the story together.

Ask your child what they think is happening based on the picture.

Emphasize the sound of /u/whenever possible.

Be sure to practise the /u/sound action – keep one hand steady and raise the other as if putting up an umbrella, and say /u//u//u/.






